In the IEA Council meeting in Beijing, the Ergonomics Society of Thailand and the Ergonomics Society of Singapore became our new federated societies, and the Association of Southeast Asian Nations Ergonomics Societies Network joined the IEA as a network in IEA Networks. At the same time, the South East Asian Ergonomics Society (SEAES) ceased to exist as the IEA federated society. Welcome, new members!

Indian Researcher Wins Prestigious Liberty Mutual Award

The 2009 Liberty Mutual Medal in Occupational Safety and Ergonomics was awarded to Dr. Suman Singh at the IEA Congress in Beijing. Dr. Singh is from the College of Home Science, Udaipur, Maharana Pratap University of Agriculture & Technology, Rajasthan, India. Selected by the International Ergonomics Association, the winning paper related to the technological empowerment of farm women to reduce their drudgeries, increase work efficiency in the context of agriculture and animal husbandry in seven States of India.

The committee was impressed by: (a) the systems approach of combining ergonomic design/redesign of equipment, development/application of a participatory training program involving and repeated field demonstrations in the proper use of the ergonomically improved farm instruments; and (b) the impact of the project, which directly benefitted 4,200 women, and potentially can benefit many more farm workers in IDC's.

The Liberty Mutual Research Institute for Safety and the IEA presents the annual Liberty Mutual Medal to recognize outstanding original research leading to the reduction of work-related injuries and/or to the advancement of theory, understanding, and development of occupational safety research. The Medal is awarded to the authors of an original scientific paper that meets criteria for innovation and impact. The most prestigious award of its kind in the field of occupational ergonomics and safety, it carries a stipend of \$10,000. An international review committee, established by the IEA, selects the winning contribution from among the applicants worldwide.

Loss of Great Leaders

Shortly after the jubilation of our successful Congress, Secretary General Eric Wang received news that two of our pioneering leaders had passed away. Earlier this month we lost Professors Bernard Metz (SELF) and Walter Rohmert (GfA). Both were important contributors to our discipline, leaders in their federated societies and the international organization that we enjoy today. As we received condolences and kind words from around the world, it is striking to note how often both are described as great humanitarians and teachers. We are fortunate to inherit their example.


Thanks to the Outgoing 16th IEA Executive
