Report on IEA '82

Program

We have received, from both inside and outside Japan, a total of 365 papers for the 8th Congress. A listing by country is provided on attached sheet 1. The number of papers submitted greatly exceeded our expectations signifying the deep interest shown by those both inside and outside of Japan. The sub-committee for Proceedings has almost completed the screening of the abstracts submitted and just yesterday the Program Committee was formed which will draw up the overall program for the Technical Sessions in the very near future.

Each abstract is being categorized into one of 31 sessions and the time and place of their presentation will be finalized very soon.

The Congress will be held in the Nihon Toshi Center and the presentation of papers will take place in 4 - 5 meeting halls from August 24 to 27.

Next concerning invited lectures, we have decided that 4 invited lecturers would be appropriate and have sent letters of request to the following four people; Dr. Oshima (Japan), Dr. Swain, Prof. Salvendy (USA), Prof. Shackel (U.K.). We have received letters of acceptance from Dr. Oshima and Dr. Swain.

Our Present plan is to have the invited lectures after the opening ceremony on August 24 or after the General Assembly on August 25.

We are also presently studying Workshops and Symposia schedule and will have drawn up and outline no later than the end of March and will then select the persons responsible.
