800 and more members	12	delegates

I beg you therefore to send me before 31st August, 1967, two lists with the mames of the delegates of the ERS for the two parts of the General Assembly 1967.

May I add here that in this second part the corresponding I.E.A members (presently 128) will have the right of nominating six delegates.
