Proposals for Amendments to the Articles Elaborated by the Council of the International Ergonomics Association

Article 1

No proposal.

Article 2

Gesellschaft für Arbeitswissenschaft, Dortmund, Germany: Line 3 and 4: delete the words "experimental psychology, anatomy, and physiology applied to".

<u>Dr. J. Perczel, Budapest, Hungary:</u>
Line 3 and 4: write "problems of anatomy, physiology, psychology, and sociology applied to human work and its environment."

Mr. H. L. Davis, Rochester, New York, U.S.A.:
First sentence: "The International Ergonomics Association is intended to bring together organizations and persons interested in applying the knowledge and approaches of experimental psychology, anatomy, physiology, and engineering to the problems of human work and its environment."

Article 3

No proposal.

Article 4

Ergonomics Research Society, London:

Section c): "Corresponding members shall be persons who have a professional interest in ergonomics, who are not members of a Federated Ergonomics Society and who do not reside in a country covered by a Federated Ergonomics Society."

Article 5

Ergonomics Research Society, and Mr. H. Ruffell Smith, London: Line 1: delete last two words "honorary members".

Dr. J. Perczel, Budapest, Hungary: First sentence: "Delegates of Federated Ergonomics Societies, honorary members, delegates nominated by the corresponding members, and members elected before 1st October, 1967, shall have one vote each when present at a General Assembly."

Prof. H. S. Belding, Pittburgh, U.S.A.:

Insert a new paragraph after the paragraph about corresponding members: "A delegate serves from the beginning of the regular General Assembly to which he has been nominated to the beginning of the next regular Assembly, or until he is replaced by action of his sponsoring group. Delegates may serve more than one term."

Ergonomics Research Society, London: Line 6, 7: replace "The delegates to the General Assembly and the Honorary members" by "and".

Top page 3: remaining five clauses delete "and the honorary members" in each.

Article 8

Dr. Robert Murray, London:
3rd paragraph: "The President and the Council shall hold
office from the time of their election"
