Minutes of the Last Council Meeting

The minutes of the Council meeting of 26th October 1965 in Paris are accepted.

Procedure at the General Assembly 1967

The procedure proposed by the General Secretary in his letter of 6th July, 1967, is accepted.

The Council discusses the amendments to the new statutes, and decides to propose to the General Assembly to effect the following amendments:

- The amendment to Article 2 by the Gesellschaft für Arbeits a) wissenschaft, Dortmund.
- The first part of the amendment to Article 4 by the Ergonb) omics Research Society: "Corresponding members shall be persons who have a professional interest in ergonomics, and who are not members of a federated ergonomics society.

- c) The amendment to Article 5 By Prof. Belding, with the following modification: "A delegate serves from the beginning of the regular general assembly to which he has been nominated to the beginning of the next general assembly, or until he is replaced by the group of members whom he represents. Delegates may serve more than one term."
- d) The amendment to Article 8 by Dr. Murray.
