## Discussion

- 1) Papers and presentation sharing between speakers: Samira Malhaoui needs our papers to make a synthesis for her institution —> in progress.
- 2) disseminating and promoting communications: an option for publication in the journal *Laboreal* is discussed. Some papers have already been published, and it will be important to have original text —> Marta and Catherine will launch a survey to evaluate the interest of the authors and think about making a broader call for publication?
- 3) next congress: methodological elements are often underdeveloped in the papers: why not hold a symposium dedicated to these issues at the next congress (London, 2027)?
- 4) events to be held before the next congress: organize a working seminar on texts (for example, with the same methodology as it can be done in the REF congress) prior to the London congress? propose a symposium as part of the next Self congress?
- 5) Webinar: The IEA encourages TCs to take part in webinars: consider a webinar in March-April 2025 with the Gender & Work TC: one person from EWAT presents, and a discussant from the G&W TC reacts, and vice versa? Céline Chatigny could contribute.
- 6) Christine Vidal-Gomel offers to collect texts by others since 1991 and create a shared library (Zotero?)
- 7) A group focusing on "transmission" issues could be set up, coordinated by J. Thébault (France) and C. Pereira (Portugal)
