

WHAT IS IEA?

The International Ergonomics Association is the global federation of human factors/ergonomics (HF/E) societies. The mission of IEA is to elaborate and advance human factors/ergonomics science and practice, and to improve the quality of life by expanding its scope of application and contributions to society.

IEA aims to promote the knowledge and practice of human factors/ergonomics by initiating and supporting international activities and cooperation. To meet these objectives, IEA

- supports international cooperation among individuals and organizations active in the field,
- facilitates the practical application of HF/E in industry and other areas, and
- encourages research in the science and practice of HF/E.

IEA is a nonprofit organization. The work of the IEA is accomplished by volunteer academicians and practitioners; however, many initiatives vital for the development of HF/E as a unique science and profession cannot be funded solely with volunteer efforts and existing resources.

Funds are therefore needed to support

- development of human factors/ergonomics worldwide, including in industrially developing countries and also in informal work sectors,
- dissemination of human factors/ergonomics knowledge to industry and to society at large,
- promotion of ergonomics education and competency standards, and
- the work of IEA Technical Committees.

IEA invites organizations and individuals who support these goals to become Sustaining Members through annual contributions.

IEA SUSTAINING MEMBERSHIP

Organizations and Corporations

The IEA Organizational Sustaining Membership program, offered to corporations and other organizations, supports the science and application of human factors/ergonomics worldwide. It also provides exposure to, and enhances the image of, institutional members.

There are four levels of organizational support, and each level offers specific benefits. The granting of IEA Sustaining Membership does not imply IEA endorsement or approval of a company's

products or services. Sustaining membership in any category does not confer the right to voice or vote in IEA Council meetings—this is an exclusive right of IEA Federated Societies.

Organizational Sustaining Membership benefits:

Gold level—US \$1,000/yea

Platinum level—US \$5,000/year

- Two complimentary registrations for an IEA Triennial Congress for each three years of sustaining membership.

Diamond level—US \$10,000/year

- Listing on the IEA website on the sustaining membership page with an option of a short description about the sustaining member (160 characters) plus the organization's logo on IEA website home page, with an active link to the member's corporate website.
- Official listing in the program of the IEA Triennial Congress.
- Complimentary distribution of the organization's promotional materials at the IEA Triennial Congress and display of the organization's logo.
- Three complimentary registrations for an IEA Triennial Congress for each three years of sustaining membership
- Electronic copy of monthly IEA NewsBriefs.
- An invited address by an IEA officer at a corporate function, can be included if desired.

Star level—US \$25,000/year

- Listing on the IEA website on the sustaining membership page with an option of a short description about the sustaining member (160 characters) plus the organization's logo on IEA website home page, with an active link to the member's corporate website.
- Acknowledgment on the inside front cover of the Triennial Congress program brochure and official listing in the program of the IEA Triennial Congress.
- Free exhibit booth for distribution of promotional materials at the IEA Triennial Congress.
- Four complimentary registrations for an IEA Triennial Congress for each three years of

sustaining membership.

- Electronic copy of monthly IEA NewsBriefs.
- An invited address by an IEA officer at a corporate function, can be included if desired.
- Additional benefits can be negotiated.

Individual Sustaining Membership
