Yes, in our country, we currently have provision for individuals who carries out ergonomics risk assessment and/or activities to be trained in accordance with the Guidelines on Ergonomics Risk Assessment at the Workplace, 2017 (Ergonomics Trained Person). However, the specific titles "Ergonomist" or "HFE specialist" were not protected by law, meaning that there were specific no legal regulations governing the use of these titles yet.
Briefly describe important activities of your Society / Network since last annual report	We successfully organized the International Conference from 8-10 September 2025, which included participation from both Malaysian and international delegates. The conference was attended by approximately 80 delegates representing various fields within ergonomics.
